A Horrible Crime Brought to Light Near Contreras, N. M.

THE CATLEMAN'S TRIAL.

A New Era in Leadville's (Col.) History—Arrest of a Butcher for Illegal Practice—Mining Notes.

Dr. O. C. Hall, a medical practitioner, has been arrested at Leadville, Colo., for practicing medicine without a license and was incarcerated in the county jail. The arrest was made at the instance of the medical profession of this city. The doctor was arrested some months ago on the same charge and served several months in the county jail.

Thirty troops confined in the old county jail at San Bernardino, Cal., attempted to break their way out the other night, but gave up the job at 2 o'clock. A large force of officers were on hand to stop them if their efforts had been successful, and the chances were that they would have been roughly handled.

A letter from Judge Jacob H. Hornum, commissioner of schools for Utah, states he has made the appointment of school trustees to the several counties in accordance with law, upon the basis of \$2.50 per capita of the number of persons of school age. The school population of Beaver is 1114, and the money for this county is \$2795.24. That amount has been reported to the auditor, who will issue a warrant for the same in favor of Beaver county—Beaver Citizen.

The coin murder mystery at Hastings, Nebraska, has been solved. The man who was the principal, and the interest in the case was intensified on Tuesday afternoon, when it was learned that Edward Mason, the husband, had been arrested as an accessory before the fact in the murder of Cole. Mason was taken before Judge Bohrer and entered a plea of not guilty. His preliminary examination was fixed for the following day, at which time sensational developments were expected. The officers say the case is closed as far as further arrests are concerned. Mason was charged with aiding and abetting in the crime.

On Monday morning in the supreme court of Idaho a decision was rendered in the case of John P. Cox, and the latter was ordered released from the penitentiary, where he had been incarcerated for over a year. Cox was confined in the district court of Idaho on account of assault with a weapon liable to produce great bodily harm. The court sentenced him to five years in the penitentiary. The court holds that as he was convicted under section 732 of revised statutes, the maximum imprisonment allowed under that section is two years, the sentence was excessive and void.

Some two weeks ago an injunction was served upon the owners of the Valley mine at Leadville, Colorado, by John Harvey of the Milford mine. The mine is situated in Big Evans gulch, east of Leadville, and each recently opened up a new looking mine of mineral. The Valley people were unwilling to let the Milford property, and the injunction was immediately served upon them. The court then decreed that the injunction be dissolved, and when the decision of the arbitrator was given, the court will at once dissolve the injunction, thereby permitting work upon the property to proceed.

The new town of Elly, New Mexico, is flourishing. A contract has just been made for a new school house \$25,000. It is to be built of brick, with two stories high, with white ceilings, twelve thick, and will be in the form of a Greek cross. It will have a main room of six which will average twenty-five feet square; the other two being 24 ft.
