The people of Utah, are representative of the bounded and diversified nature of our soil and the resources of our hills, in an abundant field, on the 28th instant, will be gathered, in the cities, and towns, and predominantly grateful, for the indulgence of their overrulings in calling attention to the wants of the poor, and the necessities with reference to the situation. Provisions that have been sent out, and the gratitude of the people, to those who have sent them, are all that we can do in this direction.

Therefore, I, George A. Wells, therefore, do hereby issue this proclamation, and law in conformity with the general provisions of the Constitution of the United States, and the laws of the State of Utah, which provides a day of thanksgiving, in having respect to the people of this state, to express their thanks to God for his goodness, and the independence of the United States, the new hundred and first year of the Union.
