

Gladstone's Address to the Electors of Midlothian?

LONDON, 13.—Gladstone issued the following manifesto to the electors of Midlothian:

"Gentlemen!—In consequence of the defeat of the bill for the better government of Ireland, the ministry advised, that the majority was not fit for decision, the dissolution of Parliament for decision by the nation is the gravest and likewise the simplest issue that can arise.
