flection as well as ground for popular Arctic Cold. A person who has never been in the polar regions can probably have no idea of what cold really is; but by reading the terrible experiences of

arctic travelers in that icy region some notion can be formed of the extreme cold that prevails there. When we have the temperature down to zero out of doors we think it bitterly cold, and If our bouses were not so warm as, at least, 60 degrees above zero, we should
