ELECTING U. S. SENATORS.

A valued correspondent in an adjoining county, takes out very plainly about the time that he considers has been served by the Legislature over the election of a United States Senator. He says the previous who have been active in the struggle "would be unable and should be suspended."

One of the things they may do is to call a meeting. While this may be done, it would be open to anyone to take advantage of the situation, and if not an endeavor, it may meet, providing and causing to postpone the election and delay over the responsibility that is a legislative or plenary whose responsibility rests upon him, he is quoted by his own source, "in case of a tie, the election must be referred to a committee of inquiry and it is liable to be misappropriated by those who are not elected."

One correspondent wants to know what is being done towards changing the present method of choosing United States senators. It should be understood that no change can take place without an amendment to the Constitution of the United States. Bills have been introduced into Congress from time to time but have not been passed for nothing. There are three choices relating to the subject before the country, the most logical and practical way of settling the question.

But public sentiment is strong, and the trend is towards a demand for the election of United States Senators by popular vote. When it becomes sufficiently feasible and extensive there will be, no doubt, some legislation by Congress, followed by the expression of the popular will for the necessary change.

A movement in this direction has been taken by the City Legislature, but the introduction of a bill in the Senate, asking that body to enact the needed legislation for the substitution of the popular vote for the Legislature of the several States. Senator Haynes Denison presented one on Friday, and it will probably receive favorable attention.

Adhering to the Constitution is a necessity, which will be and ought to be approached with caution. Thinking with that sacred instrument should not be encouraged. Only for the gravest emergency should the Legislature be allowed to add to or take from, and that the change must be made according to its own provisions as to the method.

We are of the opinion, however, that the mode of election of U. S. Senators could be changed to the advantage of the people and that the change will come in due season. Meanwhile the subject should be discussed throughout the country, and the views of the widest and most representative citizens as well as of veterans and soldiers should be obtained and well considered.

MORMONS' MODIFIED.

Today's despatches give an account of the meeting of "Mormons" in Great Britain, which shows the strong anti-religious influence that prevails among some of the people in that populous country. According to the London "Daily Telegraph," an anti-Mormon paper attacked the Saints while they were engaged in their religious service, smashed the windows, stoned and shot at the Elders, and used such violence that the police had to interfere, and two lady missionaries from Utah had to take refuge at the police station.

The date of the alleged disturbance was not given in the despatch, but it occurred, as we suppose, in probably on Sunday, Jan. 13, when the saints held their annual conference in Liverpool. Elder Herbert L. Jones, president of the conference, is president of the Conference and the other Elders from this city, Alfred Hancock and George Garfield, of the Twenty-second Ward, have been laboring as missionaries in Britain. The statement that there were also women missionaries leads us to infer that Sister Eliza F. Flagg, and Elizabeth of Almonia Park, who recently were in the service of the Lord, but later were withdrawn, because were of Indian extraction, were also elders.

Notwithstanding the apparent concurrence of the church members, however, it is certain that no services were held on the Moroni, an information of which we have from that saintly man to the Church leaders. Therefore the relatives and friends of the missionaries must be tenacious of their safety.

As for the British disturbances, the events relate to the London cabinet, which does not the dress of the hand, though they may have been the emanation of proceedings that called for the alteration of the police.
