Financial Statement.

New York, 24.—The following is the statement of the financial condition of the Pacific Mail Company, as submitted to the directors of the Panama R. R., who are considering a proposal for the consolidation of the two companies: Hills payable February 15, 1875, \$75,000; the Milwaukie charter \$38,871 gold; due John Roach, balance on three bonds, \$30,000; due John Roach extra on 20th and 31st of February, \$140,000; due the Panama R. R. \$150,000; interest on a loan of \$50,000; due in San Francisco estimated at \$25,000; due on accounts payable, estimated at \$150,000; due insurance on wooden ships \$185,000 gold; due Roach and sons on three new steamers now building \$1,500,000; cash in bank, \$80,000, besides \$30,000 shares of Pacific Mail stock.

The Line Trade—Supreme Court Decision—The Stevens Battery—Gothic Promoters.

The line trade in this city has adopted resolutions recommending a uniform duty not to exceed 5 per cent on all flag goods, and that Congress repeat all acts allowing commission upon brokerage, transportation, shipping, etc.

A special term of the Supreme Court has given a decision in favor of the plaintiff in the suit against city chambers, Palmer, to compel him to pay over to the city nearly half a million dollars interest upon funds of the city deposited in the Broadway and Tenth National banks.

Secretary Robeson, accompanied by Congressman Sargent, of Cal., and Hale, of Maine, inspected the subject to the proposed, bought for \$145,000. Professor Thurston, of the Stevens Institute of Technology, will soon furnish them with estimates of the cost of completing the battery and getting it out of the dry dock.

It is reported that Bishop Laughlin, of Brooklyn, will be chosen coadjutor bishop to Archbishop McCloskey, of New York, that Vice General, of New York, will succeed Bishop Laughlin, and that the Rev. Wm. Keegan, of Maine, will succeed Bishop of Portland, Maine.

The London Money Market—Quickerly. Private advices state that exchange at Paris on London is still at a point which permits the importation of gold into France. Many bankers here believe the Bank of England rate of discount will be advanced on Thursday next.
