SHIPPING DISASTERS.

To a Period of Listlessness After One of the Most Novel Panics.

INSTIGATED BY MAGNATES.

Plenty of Ground for Suspicion That Recent Flurry Was Aggravated By Railroad Financiers.

WALL STREET

New York, March 24 .- Wall street seems to have settled down to a period of listlessness after one of the most novel panics ever known in its history. The fact that the financial ditrict went through a crash, when security values slumped off a full billion of dollars in a few days, without a single failure being recorded is something that never before has been paralleled.

before has been paralleled. None of the market leaders expects to see any bull movement this spring even from the present comparative low range of values. The railroad situation and the agitation that has been if progress for months, from one end of the country to the other, against cor-porations and corporative influences, form a combination of circumstances likely to be too great to permit of any deded upward tendency in securities values. Neither is it expected that there will be any extensive bear raid on values in the near future. Few, if any, stock exchange houses have been able to make their expenses during the past winter, so small has been the general volume of the public's business, and litchange is expected for some months

The come. Of course, some of the interests that have been raiding the market, appar-ently for the sole purpose of demon-strating to President Roosevelt and his administration, as well as to the legis-latures in the various states, that the anti-corporation agliation has knocked the bottom out of security prices, may raid again, but it is doubtful. The ac-tions of the big financial interests were poorly shielded and their object was too well known to make it worth while for them to indulge in any further dem-enstration along the same line. On the other hand, the admittedly vast amount of money that will have to be spent in the next few years on railroad devel-opments and improvements will, it is believed, check any decided upward tendency in prices. Summed up, after the strangest sort of a panic, Wall street apparently is go-ing into a semi-comatose state from which few of the market leaders ex-pect to see it emerge until fail at least. MAGNATES RESPONSIBLE.

There is plenty of ground for sus-picion that the recent tumuituous scenes on the stock exchange were ag-gravated, if indeed they were not actu-ally instigated, by the manciers in con-trol of the railroad properties. The railroads must use vast sums of money in the near future and they must be able to get this money on failly easy

railroads must use vast sums of money in the near future and they must be able to get this money on fairly easy terms, which they realize they cannot do unless there is some change in the attitude of the public. The situation of the railroads is most trying but it is largely due to the neg-lect of the men in control of the prop-erties. During the periods of great prosperity these men made no adequate provision for the future. Too freely did they gather the future. Too freely did they gather the future. Their abuses of its market manipulation. Their abuses of its public, coming to light coinci-dentaly with high money rates in the world's markets, has brought the sub-ject home to these magnates in a way that is most unpleasant. They have been used to running things with a high hand and they do not like being obliged to cater to the general public at this time.

To this was added the wrecking of the Joy line steamship Larchmont off Watch Hill, and the stranding of the channel steamship Berlin at the Hook of Holland. Then there was the big steamship Dakota wrecked on a Jap-anese reef; the loss of two Hamburg-American steamships at Kingston; the sinking of the American steamship Hugonia near New Orleans; the acti-dent to the German steamship Nerissa at the mouth of the River Ems, and an enormous list of smaller vessels either totally lost or badly damaged. In this connection it is interesting to note that an agitation has been started for the repeal of the anti-quated federal statute of 1851 which limits the Hability of the owners of a wrecked vessel te an amount which shall in no case exceed the value of the wreck. Under this statute the Joy line can be held liable for only 38,000, which was the price for which the wreck sold. There is no way of touch-ing the marine insurance money which the corporations owning the steam-ships are able to collect. There seems to be little doubt but that this law, which is a relic of barbarism, will be repealed at the next session of Con-gress.
