The Morning and Evening Star has an editor at £10 10s. per week; two sub-editors at £5 5s. each; one foreign, £7 7s.; four reporters, £4 4s. each; manager, publisher and assistant publisher, together, £15-expenses in gross, £238 per week. All these expenses are incurred in getting ready for press, and the estimate does not include paper, so that it will be seen that the launching a new daily paper is a heavy and serious undertaking. A loss of nearly £520 per week, according to Mr. Hunt, or of £238, according to the lowest reliable estimate, must be provided for some time, as the paper cannot hope to pay for a considerable

period more than its extra outlay.
