AMERICAN. Frank James Makes a Statement. MEMPHIS, 9.—The Appeal publishes a letter purporting to be from Frank James, which is believed to be authentic.

WASHINGTON, 10.—Brief funeral services were held to-day over the remains of Representative Allen. David Davis, President of the Senate, Spenser Keifer and a large number of other congressmen were present.

REPORTED ASSASSINATION. KANSAS CITY, 10.—It was reported last night that Tucker Bashaw, who was convicted of participating in the Glendale train robbery and who was pardoned out to testify against Bill Ryan, was assassinated by the Jesse James gang.

EXPLOSION AT ST. LOUIS. ST. LOUIS, 10.—A large explosion took place in the city of St. Louis last night at 10 o'clock. The explosion was caused by the bursting of a gas pipe in a building on the corner of Olive and Madison streets.

INDIANAPOLIS, 10.—The shortage in the accounts of Arthur Mookler, the absenting cashier of the Central Bank, will reach \$20,000. The bank is closed until all the accounts which have been greatly falsified, have been overhauled.

Governor Crittenden is well regarded for the capture of Jesse James, being paid by the railroad companies. There is no truth in the report he was shot at on Saturday.

The French column overtook Bovenia's forces south of Tegrine, Africa, and completely defeated them, capturing the provision train and 25 of his men.

A storm of unexampled violence, swept the island of Vancouver on Saturday. A ship in the outer harbor was wrecked on the coast. It is feared a boat's crew of six men in attempting to board their ship were drowned.

Grave apprehensions are felt in Warsaw of the renewal of the outbreak against the Jews. Disorders are posing threatening the Jews, who are in a state of great terror.

At Constantinople, General Burden, on Friday, signed the preliminary conditions for the construction of two torpedo batteries in the Dardanelles, and two at the mouth of the Bosphorus.
