AJAX REMAINS QUITE FIRM

May Day and Lower Mammoth
Weaken—Tetro Was Very Active—
Yankee a Little Softer.

Business closed on the mining exchange today with the sale of 57,498 shares for the sum of \$35,352.37. Ajax shares were quite strong around \$1.18½, while Daily Con. Mercur sold up to \$3.70. Daily West let go 29 shares at \$25.75. A spurt was noticeable in Dalton & Lark today. From 8 cents, the price at which the opening sale was made, the stock moved up to 10 cents, and remained quite firm at the close. Grand Central sold up to \$6.64, while Lower Mammoth sold from \$4.86 down to \$4.78. May Day was much weaker at 55½, while Ontario hung around \$8.39. Silver Shield declined to 9.
