## THE REGISTRATION.

Sept. 26, 1895, is the opening of the week for final revision of the registration lists, prior to the session of the 5th of November next. During that time every voter should ascertain definitely that his name is on both the Territorial and State registration lists; if he is qualified therefor. To know that his name is on one is not sufficient, if it should be on the other also. Notwithstanding the efforts that have been made with the best to house canvas and by keeping open the registration office in Salt Lake City, and the urging that has been done here, there are still many, the number being reported as reaching into the thousands in the city, whose names are not on the registration lists, and who are entitled to have them there. This condition here is typical, to some extent, of that which exists elsewhere, hence the necessity of some stirring up on this subject.

The Salt Lake county registrar, Mr. E. W. Wilson, suggests that make a statement of the qualifications of voters on each of the registration lists, that the matter may be thoroughly understood, and every one be given full opportunity to know and exercise his rights in the premises. In making this statement, it may be remarked that the qualifications of voters for officers under the Territorial laws and of those for State officers are wholly separate from each other in important particulars.

First.—Votes for municipal, county or Territorial officers must subscribe to the Edmunds-Tucker law, which fixes certain qualifications, among them being residence in the Territory six months, and in the present thirty days previous to the election. There are also requirements concerning certain offenses under the United States law. Only those who register under this law can vote for the officers named.

Second.—Votes for all State officers, whether executive, legislative or judicial, must be residents in the Territory for one year prior to the day of election. This is the only qualification except that of male citizens over 21 years of age. No title of residence in precinct or county is fixed; nor are the other qualifications of the Edmunds-Tucker act applied.

This statement of the differing qualifications seems so clear that every citizen should comprehend the differences between the two registrations, and the News again expresses the hope that every citizen will realize the responsibility resting upon him to perform his whole duty as an elector.

## THE UNIVERSITY OPENING.

The first week of the current University session has ended, and it is safe to say a more prosperous beginning has never attended the same weeks of any past academic year. Attention already has been called through the columns of the News to the interesting and extensive preparation made by the effects of the institution, as the enlarged scope of the University's work is now to be added that all the additional accommodations will be available to the students rapidly to provide for the students in attendance. The registration at present exceeds that of any previous year, and for grade. The week preceding the last was devoted to the examination of applicants for admission, and though the strictest tests have been applied, and many candidates have been rejected, the first registration day witnessed the enrollment of over 250 new students; others have been admitted since, and these, together with such of the old

students as have returned, make a present attendance of over 500 qualified students. The registration of former students has not yet been perfected, previous to which there are now applicants who have either omitted or delayed the payment of tuition fees, and when reports are received the total will be far greater than the numbers above given.

But the gratifying satisfaction which all friends of the institution see in the evidence of its growth and the growth of its property is but a small part of the number that are the pride of ownership of the students. Most of those now admitted for the first time are regular graduates of accredited schools, while they enter with no combination of unusual requirements behind them, and they stand upon an advanced course of study designed to fit them for the most favorable situations. A high degree of learning has been attained between the secondary schools and the University, so that graduation from the State institution without higher institutions without break or hindrance. This is true of students who fall from the well-established denominational schools, as of those whose primary and secondary training have been received in the lower grades of the public school system. Among the less refined schools, whose courses of study cover the surface requirements in the college work at the University, and whose graduates are therefore admitted to the higher courses without examination are Salt Lake City High School, Ogden High School, Brigham Young College, Provo, Brigham Institute, Salt Lake College, Latter-day Saints' College, and Rowland Hall, of Salt Lake City.

The Normal School of Utah, which is made by law an integral part of the University, has received an unusually large influx of students, and this in spite of the elevation of the course and increased requirements for graduation. In the plan of the three years' course of normal training heretofore mentioned, last year's work may not be requisite for graduation; and although this change in course could not be forced, upon students already registered and in full standing in the older, shorter, courses, most of the old three year candidates have passed their applications to be allowed to change to the four year curriculum. The enlarged and thoroughly equipped training school maintained through the courteous cooperation of the city board of education is a most valuable addition to the University facilities, and the most harmonious spirit characterizes the work of this, as of all other departments of the institution.

The newly prepared laboratory rooms are models of completeness and convenience. Every room in the several large buildings devoted to University work is in continuous service.

A commendable feature of the current plan is the continuation of non-resident courses, whereby earnest students who are detained from regular attendance may pursue their work under the direction of the Faculty before graduation such students must spend at least one year in residence at the University. With this same purpose of extending the benefits of the institution to those besides regular students, courses of public lectures will be maintained during the winter months; and further, visitors are welcome at all times in the class exercises and lectures, as far as the seating capacity of the rooms will permit.

In closing, we may say that Dr. Talma, president of the University, states that uncollected valuation with the prospects of the institution is left by every officer; and with the present bright outlook we do not see how he could be otherwise with educators inspired by a love of their high calling in the community. With such a beginning and such promises, the success of the year just opening is assured.

## A STURDY GOVERNOR.

The better class of our people should rise up in one man and tender a vote of thanks to the governor of Texas for the action he has taken to prevent an organized infraction of good order on the soil of his state. Emboldened by the failure of the executive of a sister southern state to prevent a price fight from taking place two years ago, a nest of conspirators, calling themselves sporting men sought to nullify the laws of Texas, as they had those of Florida, and had well nigh accomplished their purpose. If Governor Culverhouse had been less determined or more uncertain as to whether or not his authority could be exercised, undoubtedly the law-defenders would have prevailed, and the majority of the commonwealth been at naught.
