LOCAL SELF-GOVERNMENT IN

THE TERRITORIES.

Speech of Hon. William R. Steele,

of Wyoming, in the House of

Representatives, Saturday, July

29, 1876.

(CONTINUED)

But the country now formed in

territories is largely composed

of mineral and pastoral lands,

which will not attract or support

a dense population as the agricul-

tural lands have done, so that the

territorial governments will for

many instances be permanent in

their character for many years to

come. In this condition of affairs

it becomes the duty of the legis-

lature to devise a system of gov-

ernment which will render the

people contented and happy, which

will aid in the development of the

resources of the country, and in ad-

dition to the wealth, power, and pros-

perity of a common country.

Mr. Steele, in speaking of the

form of government in the Terri-

tories and of the condition of a

country which would be for a con-

siderable period a territory, is in

the first volume of his Commu-

nities, sec. 356:
