Chill and Peru is not yet signed. Being asked what, in his epinion, was Chill's motives in trying to es abish Iglesias, the Peruvis minister replies, the government of Chill does not want to make peace dues not wish for peace; but only seeks a pretext for continuing her occupation of Peru, meaning that its act in setting up Iglesias is to create anarchy in Peru, to set the Peruvians to fighting among themselves so as to justify its occupation of Peruvian territory. Chill is seeking to make arrange ments with Brazil and the Argen tine Republic which will prevent these governments from giving her any trouble on account of her war conquest, and with this object is holdling out to them inducements to become interested. Elmer and Sec-retary Frelinghuysen sometime ago submitted him a proposi ion fr peace between the two countri a which he (Eime:) thought would te acceptable to Peru; but of course Chili, which has not recognized Oalderon, has thus far refu-ed to accede to the wishes of the United States. "I think," sa'd Elm "that the good offices of the United States will finally be successful Another thing; public opinion in Chill is, according to all information I have received, changing and set ting against the outrageous policy of the Chillan Government.
