Layton—There was an aurora, probably the same day as the last.

Lay—Temperatures below the average; clouds much below the average.

Paterson—No precipitation from the 1st to the 10th, except the snow which covered the ground, half an inch wide on the high ways, about one-half inch on the roads, and wide with the trees, about one-half inch wide on the right side. HOW TO KEEP YOUR HELP?

Some Practical Suggestions That Will Do Help in Domestic.

Make your kitchen the best room in your house, for the floor lay with tiles of a small, neat pattern which can be washed with warm water and milk, wiped after with a soft cloth.
