In compliance with the desires of President Hayes, the Sultan has decided to retain the Turkish Legation at Washington.

LONDON, 18.—At Belfast yesterday, rioting was renewed. Mounted police charged the mob and 20 persons were arrested. Some houses were wrecked by the rioters.

It is stated the Marquis Tseng, embassador of China to Russia, has been informed that Russia will not consent to further negotiate with China. Marquis Tseng awaits fresh instructions from Pekin.

The cholera is raging in a village near Tusun in Roumania, causing an average of 15 deaths daily.

As a result of the meeting of the iron masters of the west of Scotland, many furnaces in Lanarkshire were blown out. The strike is spreading to Ayershire. Considerable inconvenience is being felt in consequence of the scarcity of coal. Several traders between Greenock and Quebec have been obliged to sail with ballast instead of coal.
