REMARKS Morning, April 8, 1857.

I rise before the congregation to make a few remarks by request of my brethren and by the true; how can it be otherwise?] It can't, and I call of the Spirit of my Heavenly Father which I feel within me.

Young: That is verily true, sir.] Now you that have on such a yoke had better pull out the bow keys, throw off the yoke, and then put one on that won't chafe you, for I tell you as the Lord God Almighty lives, it is now or never with the Latter Day Saints. The Lord has been merciful unto us and has called to us by the mouth of his servants and his Prophets that are here, and has given us an opportunity to renew our covenants and again receive the blessings which it is our right and privilege to peo; le. enjoy. Supposing the Lord should take away these Prophets and Apostles from amongst us, I want . to know how many of this people there are who would ever find their way to heaven? There is not a man nor woman that would ever do it; they would slumber and sleep and be lost in the darkness and confusion that envelop the world. We have revelation upon revelation, precept upon precept, and shall I say, here a little and there a little? No, but I will say that we have handed out to us here a good deal and there a good deal. Here is the fountain of life, and I feel that it is the duty of all to improve upon that which they receive, for this is the day of salvation, and "how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation?" I believe there will be no way of escape for those who are slothful and indifferent.
