

SIX YEARS IN PRISON

Denial Keeler Sentenced for the Killing of Fred Nibbeling.

SENTENCE ON WILLIAM McGUIRE

Assigned To Prison for the Murder of Fred Nibbeling.

Denial Keeler, who on the last term of the criminal court was convicted of the crime of involuntary manslaughter, was sentenced this morning by Judge Allen to serve six years in the Utah prison.

The prisoner's attorney was given thirty days in which to file a bill of exceptions and prepare a motion for a new trial.

The crime for which Keeler was tried was the killing of Fred Nibbeling, a private in the fifth infantry, at a house in the eastern part of town over a year ago.

WILLIAM McGUIRE

William McGUIRE, convicted of actual murder, appeared for sentence, and the prosecuting attorney of the same was postponed till tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock.

James H. Bacon and others will plead tomorrow morning in the criminal court to thirty-two indictments growing out of the failure of the bank of Salt Lake.
