FOUND MOUNTAIN IS MAKING GOOD

Sunnyside Mill is Turning Out Large Quantity of the Yellow Bullion.

FULL CAPACITY 2,000 TONS.

Fine Showing Now Disclosed in Mine

—Good Quality of Gold.

Louis D. Gordon, of Salt Lake, the discoverer of the new Lomont Round Mountain district in Nevada, who is heavily interested in the Sunnyside mine and mill in this camp, is more than pleased with the operation of both mine and mill during the month of November, and has received word that the mill output for the period stated was nearly \$20,000 in the yellow metal, and that the bullion is now safely stored in the safe of the company, awaiting transportation to the mint. When the mill is running to its full capacity the plant will probably handle from 1,800 to 2,000 tons of ore monthly.

PROPERTY IN FINE SHAPE.

In speaking of the condition of the Sunnyside property the Nugget, or Round Mountain, says:

On Tuesday mine superintendent James McDonald secured some wonderful paintings from the old Spencer-Baily-Campbell lease.

A piece of rock half the size of a man's fist panned between two and three carats worth of gold. To the naked eye, only one or two small particles of gold were visible before the rock was broken up and panned, after which was discovered a pan of the gleaming particles some of them as large as nail parings. The color was a much deeper shade of yellow than usually characterizes the gold in the district, and it is believed to be a higher grade of the metal.

The work of following down the hanging wall of the big ledge on the 250 foot level has been temporarily suspended while the main incline is being extended. The pitch of this extension will not be quite as steep as the original work and its purpose is to cut the ledge mentioned, at a point some distance below the winze which was being sunk.

The company house has been completed and is an attractive two story frame building with a porch on the side overlooking Big Smoky Valley. The interior work has of course not been finished. This will be used as offices and living rooms for the officers and directors of the company and their friends when visiting the camp.
