The Decision of the Electoral Commission.

Washington, Feb. 12. The electoral commission

has decided that the grounds

of their decision are that it is not

competent, under the constitution

and law as it existed at the date of

the passage of the act constituting

the commission to go into evidence

outside of the papers opened by the

President of the Senate in the

presence of two of the House, to

prove that other persons than those

regularly certified to by the Gov-

ernor of Florida, according to the de-

termination and declaration of the

board of State canvassers, had been

required for the performance of

their duties, had been appointed

electors, or by counter proof to show

that they had not, and that all pro-

ceedings of the court or acts of the

legislature, or of the executive of

Florida, subsequent to the casting

of votes of the electors on the pre-

ceding day are inadmissible for any

purpose. As to the objection

made to the eligibility of

Humphreys, the commission is of

the opinion that without reference

to the question of the effect of the

act of an ineligible elector, the

evidence does not show that he

held the office of shipping commis-

sioner on the day when the electors

were appointed.

The commission also decided, as a

consequence of the foregoing and

upon the grounds before stated,

that neither of the papers purport-

ing to be certificates of the electors

of the United States, and they

ought not to be counted as such.
