LONDON, 12 -The rate of discount of the bank of England has been reduced one per cent., and is now five per cent. A meeting in support of the Tichborne claimant was held at St. James' Hall last night. The principal speakers were, Whalley, M. P., Onslow and the claimant bimself. PARIS, 12 -The Left in the Assembly are much censured for raising inopportunely the question of dissolution, and their giving the Germans the pretext for rejecting the guarantees for the payment of the war indemnity, and an excuse for refusing to evacuate the territory. Goulard, Minister of the Interior, has instructed the prefects to prohibit the signing of petitions in wine shops for dissolution.
