


COLD FRAMES IN WINTER.

Some of the Work That is Accomplished with Them by Vegetable Gardeners. In these days of progressive farming cold frames form an important adjunct to both the vegetable and the flower garden.

Cold frames for winter work should face the south or southeast to give them the benefit of the sunshine, but wherever cold frames are placed protect them from the north and northwest winds.

It is important that the frames be well covered with straw or manure, and that the covering be kept in place during the winter months.
