

## BRYAN REPLIES TO BAILEY'S SPEECH

Denies Democratic Defeat of 1894 Was Caused by Doctrine of Free Raw Material.

### PLATFORM BINDS CANDIDATES

Tex. Senator Does Not Express an Opinion on This Particular Subject.

EL PASO, TEXAS, Sept. 20.—As he was leaving El Paso tonight after delivering two addresses, W. J. Bryan gave out an interview in reply to Senator Bailey's recent Dallas speech relative to the tax on raw material. Mr. Bryan denies that the Democratic defeat in the congressional elections of 1894 was caused by the doctrine of free raw material in the Wilson bill.

"He certainly has not forgotten that the defeat of 1894 was caused by the doctrine in the Democratic ranks over the free trade question," Mr. Bryan declares. "Senator Bailey's speech over the Democratic success in the presidential campaign of 1892 was a Democratic victory and to misrepresent a congressional defeat to support of the senator's theory."

"The main part of Senator Bailey's speech is devoted to an attempt to answer the argument that a duty on raw material is always transferred to the consumer. He recognizes that he must overcome that argument or confess his policy would put a higher tax upon the consumer than the consumer would have to pay under our policy. He labors to prove that a tax on raw material would not be transferred under his policy but he inadvertently uses one sentence that establishes my position. He says: 'If the manufacturer transfers the tax on his raw material to his consumer, then I will tell you how to prevent him from doing so. It is as simple as the alphabet. Let us take it off the finished product as he cannot transfer his tax to the raw material.'"

"This is more than simple; it is absurd. 'My proposition stands that a tax on raw material is transferred to the finished product and paid by the consumer.'"

### ADVERTISING PLOT ENDS DISASTROUSLY

LOS ANGELES, CAL., Sept. 20.—Protesting that he had only participated in a harmless plot to steal an actress' diamonds for advertising purposes and asking that he be given probation in order that he might continue in the field of medicine might not be forever blighted, Lee R. Warren, a young medical student, was sentenced today to serve six years in San Quentin penitentiary for burglary by Judge Crowe of Santa Barbara county.

Warren was convicted of having stolen \$450 worth of diamonds belonging to Betty Harte, an actress. The court refused to accept his plea that it was an advertising scheme and scored the prisoner for having dragged his girl wife into the affair by inducing her to pawn the jewelry.

### INDEPENDENTS NAME JUDGE GAYNOR FOR MAYOR

NEW YORK, Sept. 20.—The first independent body of citizens of Greater New York to choose a candidate for mayor for the approaching municipal election selected tonight for this honor, Supreme Court Justice William Gaynor of Brooklyn. He was nominated with enthusiasm at a Cooper Union mass meeting of the Municipal Democracy, an organization of progressive Democrats of the city. The required petition to make the nomination legal was then circulated and 1,100 signatures were obtained. Two thousand are required.

### PARROT CRIED "STOP THIEF" AND HE WAS CAUGHT

SAN FRANCISCO, Sept. 21.—"Stop thief!" vociferously shrieked by a big green parrot swinging from its perch in a cage which was being rapidly carried down the street in this city by Terry Rooney led to his arrest and incarceration on a charge of grand larceny preferred by Harry Poller, a restaurateur who owns the bird. When the case was called in court yesterday the parrot was present as a witness and when her owner told the story of how Rooney had snatched the cage from its place in front of his restaurant, the bird from time to time hurled the epithet "wine bum" at her abductor.

### GIVEN A FORTUNE ON WISE CONDITION

NEW YORK, Sept. 21.—The will of Ellen M. Hennessey, widow of former Fire Commissioner James S. Hennessey, leaves a one-third interest in her \$60,000 estate to her 15-year-old grand daughter, Catherine Bradley Hignelow, provided that at no time shall she marry a divorced man or an actor. In case the girl does marry a divorced man or an actor she shall forfeit her interest in the estate, according to the will, and her portion shall revert to Mrs. Hennessey's son, J. Forbes Hennessey, and a daughter, Ellen Mary Parker.

## PEARY'S CABIN BOY KNEW ABOUT COOK

Before Came South on Roosevelt Aware There Was Going to Be a Controversy.

### HIS RETICENCE A SURPRISE.

Pritchard Cautioned Not to Say Anything—Murphy Was Away At the Time.

SYDNEY, N. S., Sept. 20.—The tug Douglas H. Thomas, which left Battle Harbor Saturday morning in company with the Peary steamer Roosevelt, arrived here at daylight this morning and reported the Roosevelt traveling south under steam and sail at a speed approximating 10 knots an hour.

According to the statement made last Saturday at Battle Harbor by William Pritchard, cabin boy and assistant cook on the Roosevelt, two persons knew as long ago as last April that Dr. Frederick A. Cook claimed he had reached the pole April 21, 1908. These persons are Harry Whitney, a wealthy sportsman of New Haven, Conn., who is at present on the Greenland coast on board the steamer Jodelle, and Pritchard himself. They saw Cook at Annatook, Greenland, after his return from the north.

The only reference to Dr. Cook which Whitney is known to have made on his first sojourn on board the Roosevelt was a casual remark to a member of the Peary party that he believed Dr. Cook had reached the pole.

### PRITCHARD KEPT NEWS.

Pritchard kept the news more faithfully and his statement of Saturday was the first intimation that he had any information on this subject. Pritchard explained that he kept the news to himself because he did not wish to be dragged into the trouble.

He was asked how he knew, before he came south on the Roosevelt, that there was going to be a controversy, and said Dr. Cook had cautioned him not to speak to any one until he reached civilization.

Pritchard's reticence with this important news in his possession was a surprise to everybody on board the Roosevelt. In the beginning Pritchard told the correspondent that Cook had talked freely to him at Annatook with regard to his dash over the ice, indicating to him on a map the route he had followed. Later Pritchard modified this by explaining that Cook's story was told to Whitney and that he (Pritchard) said Dr. Cook had only two Eskimos with him at the pole. The language barrier made it impossible for Pritchard to talk with these Eskimos.

### MURPHY ASTONISHED.

John Murphy, the boatswain of the Roosevelt, who was ashore with Pritchard when Dr. Cook appeared at

### PLAYED CHOPIN'S FUNERAL MARCH AS HE ASPHYXIATED

CHICAGO, Sept. 21.—While illustrating one slowly asphyxiated him, Salvatore Cerrano, a violinist, 36 years old, yesterday calmly played Chopin's funeral march until overcome by the poison, he died. He had broken the gas fixtures in order to commit suicide. His violin was heard by other roomers in the house and soon after the strains issued, the smell of gas caused an investigation. When Salvatore Cerrano, a brother musician, broke into the room he found Cerrano dead, sitting in a chair. Cerrano's lifeless left hand still held the violin, while the right was locked to the bow, with which he had caressed the strings of the instrument until life was extinct.

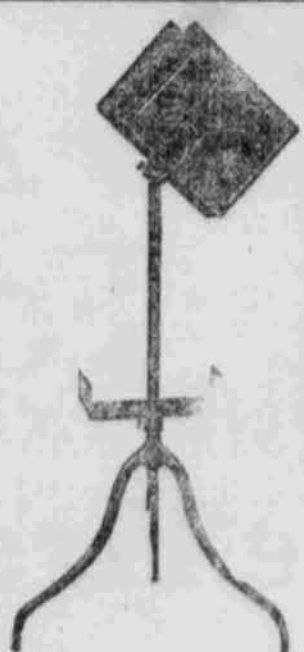
