WASHINGTON, 4.—Gresham, who  
accepted the Postmaster General-  
ship, was born in Harrison Co., Ind.,  
in 1832; and after graduation at the  
Indiana State University, studied  
law and began practice in Corydon.  
He was from the first successful.  
Shortly before the outbreak of the  
late war he was elected Representative  
in the State Legislature, and in 1861  
was chairman of the House  
committee on military affairs.  
While occupying this position he  
operated as a shillie in the  
organization of the State militia,  
and in raising and forwarding  
troops, that the latter in 1861  
commanded the 10th Indiana  
volunteers; in March, 1862, he was  
promoted to be Colonel of the Fifty-  
third Indiana, and in 1863, to  
Brigadier General of volunteers. He  
participated in the siege of Corinth,  
siege of Jackson, Miss., and up to  
January, 1864, commanded the Third  
Brigade, Fourth Division, 17th army  
corps. He was breveted Major Gen-  
eral for distinguished gallantry, and  
after January, 1864, commanded the  
Fourth Division, 17th corps, until  
July of the same year, when he was  
severely wounded in action before  
Atlanta. He was mustered out of  
service on the 30th April, 1870,  
and as soon as his health and  
strength were fully restored, he en-  
tered into partnership with Judge  
Butler, of New Albany, Ind., and  
resumed the practice of law in that  
city. In 1879 he was appointed dis-  
trict judge for Indiana.
