Chris Hildebrandt, of Weiser, says the Bojse Statesman, the well known Rapid Boise Statesman, the well known Rapid river mining man, now a resident of Iowa, who has been doing assess-ment work on his Rapid river proper-ties, has made one of the most import-ant strikes of the season.
