FOLLOWING THE VEIN. On the Eagle's Nest the vein has been opened up in two shafts a hundred feet apart. In No. 1 shaft eight feet of the lead gave an average of S112 clear across at the 30-foot level. In the No. 2 shaft the vein was struck at 6 feet. It pitched away from the shaft, which is perpendicular. At the 20-foot level the shaft passed through the vein. At the 40-foot level crosscutting was be-gun to catch the vein again. It was encountered within 6 feet of the shaft, and crosscutting for days revealed no hanging wall. When the crosscut meas-need 26 feet what appeared to be the banging wall was reached, but drilling from 30-inch hole into the supposed hanging wall gave assay returns of \$41 per ton, and what appeared at first to be the hanging wall is now found to be a good grade of orc.
