## DISTANTING ARMY OF CHICKENS

Quite a large number of cattle fed  
steers have been shipped out of Arizona  
during the past week, and a few of  
them having been finished on the  
new cut steers.

J. H. Dolph, a planter farmer of  
Arizona, has died at his home after  
a life of 74 years. He was at one  
time a prosperous wheat shipper, and  
died poor, having lost his property in a  
speculation. His failure, seven years  
ago, precipitated a social panic which  
caused many others to follow him.

A special meeting of the Pueblo  
City Council has been called to  
consider the action necessary to be  
taken to provide for the wants of the  
poor people who have been compelled  
to leave or plan to leave the town.  
The work of the city will be left  
to a committee, consisting of two  
members of the same, which will be  
elected at the same time.

Cyrus Williams, a wealthy bachelor  
living near Victoria, British  
Columbia, east of Vancouver, N.B., on  
the 26th instant, was found dead in his  
house on Sunday night. Several days  
ago Williams and several companions  
planned to go to Victoria, where he  
was to meet his old friend, John  
Furner, a fur-trader, who was  
then engaged in Williams' department  
store, according to the verdict of the coroner's jury.  
His only known relative is a sister  
who resides in Boise City, Idaho.

A colony of one hundred families of  
thrifty Mormons have settled near  
Ogallala, Wyo., says the Red Lodge  
Daily, Tues., July 26, on a big  
ditch taken out from the Grey Bull  
River and are preparing to reclaim  
150,000 acres of desert. The land lies  
between Grey Bull and Dry Creek.  
These hardy people have no won-  
derful means of getting water, but  
use Idaho and do doubts they will do the  
same in northern Wyoming. Dr.

week, asked them where they were  
likely to go to their trading, and  
replied that they would go to Red  
Lodge as this is the nearest shipping  
point and the roads are the best to this  
place. Red Lodge also has a fine  
market for produce.

Thousands of acres of fertile agricultural  
land along the Platte river in  
Wyoming now lie idle because of the  
expense of irrigation, some say as  
high as \$100 per acre. F. M. Harvey,  
of Cheyenne, has invented a  
method, however, which reduces  
the cost of irrigating to the banks of  
the river at the rate of 1000 gallons a  
minute. The cost of the plant is less  
than \$300. Ranchmen in that section  
have three pumps, each pumping  
the water from the river into the  
Platte valley. Three-fourth of these plants  
would fill enough water over banks  
twenty feet high to irrigate thousands  
of acres.

John Hansen has confessed to the  
murder of his wife at Bear Creek, Colo.,  
and also to the robbery of the stagecoach  
which she was under lock and key. He  
took the keys from the pocket of the  
dead woman and passed to the till the  
carriage drivers. Not finding the  
money as he expected he called John  
Smyth, a telegraph operator, and told  
him his wife had been killed. Hansen  
states that the weapon used by him  
in committing the crime was a gun.  
His statement was very  
short, however, no evidence of torture  
whatsoever was found. The information  
was conveyed to Sheriff Smith, however, that a mob of Pueblo  
and Colorado men had gathered to  
the upper town, and only waited a  
leader to seal the jail and turn the  
keys over to the sheriff. The sheriff  
to protect the prisoner, and therefore  
declares that if Hansen is reached by  
the mob it will be with the sacrifice of  
many of the rioters' lives and after  
walking over his body.
