

Pure Food Law Responsible For Certified Milk.

BEFORE the close of the year \$75,000 will be spent by the dairymen in purifying the small river of milk—5,000 gallons a day—which is delivered in Salt Lake City. As a result of the expenditure of this amount of money and the enforcement of the pure food laws, the quality of the milk has been so wonderfully improved, as well as the sanitary conditions, that "certified milk" will be placed on the market by the first of the year.

In the last six months the volume of business has been materially increased on account of the improved conditions. There are 38 dairies in Salt Lake county which conduct a retail business here, and 102 dairymen who ship milk each morning and night into Salt Lake within a radius of 100 miles. This is an increase of one-fifth in the number of dairies and the consumption of milk is increased accordingly.

Because the public prefers milk that is cheap to milk that is pure, an authority says, it has been difficult to educate the public mind to that point where it would ask, "How good is it?" instead of "How much does it cost?" But the dairymen have responded willingly to the provisions of the pure food laws and ordinances and as a result a better milk supply.

While inspection shows that the quality of milk that is furnished has been improved, it has been demonstrated that ideal conditions cannot be obtained in milk sold at 10 cents a quart. Under the ordinance "certified milk" means a milk from well-fed and healthy cows, free from the germs of tuberculosis and handled with a degree of care that keeps it from the contamination of barnyard dirt. It means a milk delivered in sealed bottles cooled at the dairies and delivered in the original packages to the consumer. To produce it takes care and considerable money to establish a plant. But the dairymen realize that this milk will be demanded and it can be produced with as much profit at 12 to 14 cents a quart as filthy milk at a cheaper price.

SPLENDID SCORES.

In one or two dairies, the second scoring shows that the dairymen do almost everything but brush their

commissioner, is now making a tour of the dairies which supply Salt Lake with milk. Out of the 45 dairies visited the second time he found that 32 were scoring above 45 points, the government standard. The first score showed that the dairies were on an average in fair condition but nothing extra. Before a dealer can sell milk in Salt Lake he must secure a permit, his place inspected and scored and a strict compliance with the ordinance adhered to or his permit will be revoked. After the first of the year every dairy which supplies Salt Lake with milk will have to maintain a score of 50 or above.

STANDARD REQUIRED.

The required standard is as follows: "Milk and cream, as used in this ordinance, shall be deemed to be adulterated in any of the following cases:

- (a) Milk containing more than 88 per cent of water or fluids.
- (b) Milk containing less than 12 per

cent of milk solids.

(c) Milk containing less than 22-10 per cent of fat.

(d) Milk drawn from animals within 20 days before or five days after parturition.

(e) Milk drawn from animals fed on distillery waste, or any substance in a state of fermentation or putrefaction, or any unwholesome food.

(f) Milk drawn from cows kept in a crowded or unhealthy condition.

(g) Milk from which any part of the cream has been removed.

(h) Milk which has been diluted with water or any other fluid, or to which has been added, or into which has been introduced any foreign substance whatever.

(i) Milk the temperature of which is higher than 55 degrees Fahrenheit, or which contains an excess of bacteria; provided, that the provisions of this subdivision relating to temperature shall not become effective before Oct. 1, 1909, after that date, all milk found

to have a higher temperature than 55 degrees Fahrenheit, the commissioner or any officer of the health department may seize, confiscate and destroy.

(j) Milk having a specific gravity of

less than 1.029 at 60 degrees.

(k) Milk containing any pathogenic bacteria.

(l) Milk containing any boracic or salicylic acid, formaldehyde or other foreign chemical, or any preservative whatsoever.

(m) Milk containing bacteria of any kind, more than 500,000 per cubic centimeter.

(n) Milk drawn from any cow having a communicable disease, or from a cow or cows in a herd which contains any diseased cattle, or from a cow or cows in a herd the attendants of which are afflicted with or have been exposed to any communicable disease.
