

TRAINING IN THE PRIESTHOOD

The resolution of the High Council of this Stake of Zion published in Friday evening's DESERET NEWS, is worthy the attention of others than those to whom it is specially addressed.

There is a very large body of Elders in the Church, and this is quite right in consideration of the magnitude of the great latter-day work which is yet but dimly opened to the general view.

Some of these have been recommended to that office simply to give them an opportunity of receiving the blessings of the House of the Lord.

It would seem that if a young man is to go into the Temple, receive its ordinances and enter into the holy estate of sacred matrimony, he should be worthy to receive that portion of the Melchisedek Priesthood.

It is desirable, of course, that every young man and every young lady who enters into the marriage relation should be qualified and worthy to be sealed according to the law of the Priesthood.

In order to train our young men so that when the proper time arrives they may be ready to assume the responsibilities of the higher Priesthood, they should, as a rule, be inducted into the duties of the lesser, by ordination into the quorums which have been organized according to divine revelation.

A very wide field is open to the lesser Priesthood. Read the duties required of its incumbents in the Book of Doctrine and Covenants. They are vitally important to the welfare and dependent upon the faithful discharge of those duties.
