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POLITICAL MENTION.

Who Will Be Salt Lake City's Next Mayor?

A VERY INTERESTING QUESTION.

Mayor Backin Still Clings Tenaciously to the Claim That There Will Be No Vacancy to Fill.

The question as to who will be Salt Lake City's next mayor is one that is proving a fruitful theme for political discussion and every day and night the newspapers of the respective parties are placing before the public a list of names who are claiming to be the next mayor.

In the Republican camp the names of M. H. Evans, James G. Thompson and C. F. Mason are most prominently mentioned for that high office, and today friends of each were claiming a majority of the delegates elected at yesterday's primaries.

There was another element—one of no immediate following—who say that a "dark horse" surprise is one of the strong probabilities.

In the Continental market building, where the question of nominating a candidate for mayor and of nominating a candidate for city clerk and of nominating a candidate for city treasurer, is looked upon somewhat differently than in the councils of the opposition. All nominations of candidates for municipal offices will be made after the city election, and will be in accordance with the right of present city officials to hold over until the next city election.
