## SWEEPING ALL BEFORE THEM.

Brig. Gen. Wheaton's Column Advances Today Beyond Pasig.

## COMMUNICATION IS SHUT OFF.

Rebels Avenue of Intercourse is Now Closed North and South by the American Cordón—Another Running Fight in Which the Insurgents Suffer Heavy Losses.

Manila, March 14.—At 11 o'clock this morning, knowing the insurgent forces were in the city, the American column advanced on the left of the Pasig river. No reply was made, and at 1:30 the Twenty-second regular infantry advanced until they encountered a number of volleys. This fire was returned with interest.

The line then wheeled toward Pasig in the following order: The Oregon volunteers, the Tenth regiment, the Washington volunteers, a battery detachment, the Twenty-second regular and reserve infantry. The troops followed the route, while the guerrillas made a dash for the Pasig river. Three rebel columns were captured in the river.

The rebel sharpshooters at Calabac continue active, but no casualties are reported.

AMERICAN LINE ADVANCES.
