COUNCIL HEEDS PEOPLE'S WISHES.

Street Committee Will Recommend That North State Street Be Not Paved.

PROPERTY OWNERS PROTEST. Newhouse Franchise Will be Taken Up Wednesday Night—Trip To Lime Quarry.

A number of property owners protested against the paving and stated that if the city and board of education properties were eliminated from the frontage there would be enough protests of private property owners to defeat it. As a large majority of the property owners are opposed to the improvement, the committee decided to recommend that the ordinance be not passed.
