BRIEF TELEGRAMS.

Wood fires are destroying considerable property in Wisconsin.

The Wagner Sleeping Car Company has established a central office in Chicago.

The Irving Hall of Democracy proposed to unite in the delegation to the National Convention.

The Treasury Department today purchased 300,000 ounces of fine silver, to be delivered at the Philadelphia and New Orleans mints.

The Supreme Court today overruled the petition for a rehearing in the case involving the validity of the constitutional amendments.

The London and San Francisco Bank, in California, has received to reduce its capital from \$200,000 to \$120,000 sterling.

The national convention of passenger ticket agents adjourned today in New York, to meet in St. Louis on the third Tuesday of next March.

A movement is in progress for the consolidation of the coastwise fast freight lines on the Vanderbilt railroads.

The ship *Lucille* is at San Francisco, with 3,100 packages for New York, and 2,500 packages in transit for New York.

A fire this morning destroyed Durbin & Co's drug store and contents, in Denver. The loss is \$40,000. Several smaller stores were damaged by water to the extent of about \$20,000.

The Cigar Makers' International Union at Chicago yesterday adopted resolutions that all local unions should suspend inaugurating any new strikes for an advance of wages until the spring of 1881.

The delegates to the Pennsylvania Presbyterian church congress met this morning in the Academy of Music, Philadelphia. Rev. William Paxton, D.D., of New York, preached a sermon.

Six of the best vessels of the Russian Pacific squadron have been ordered by telegraph to hold themselves in readiness to return immediately to the Mediterranean in the event of Russian affairs taking a serious turn.

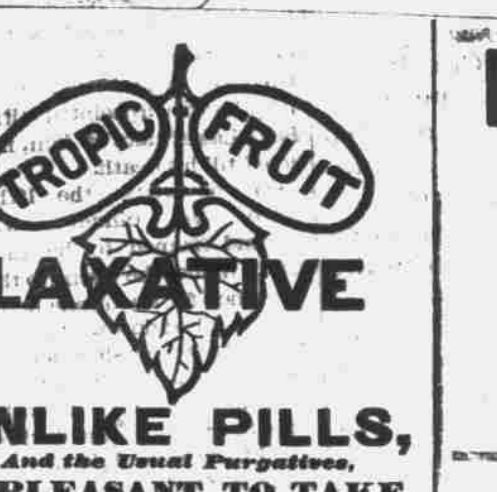
