The doctor tried to probe for the pellets, but found they had penetrated the brain and there was no hope for her life. The boy told contradictory stories, but held the shooting was purely accidental. He is known as being wild and headstrong, having been taken from the home for the Friends in this city a month ago. The Grangers were very much attached to the little girl, and the theory is that the boy shot her in a jealous rage.
