The French Army Placed in War Positions on the Frontier.

PARIS, April 29.—Two newspapers of this city today announce that French armies on the German frontier will be increased in the night. The military districts of Metz, Verdun and Nancy will take up war positions along the frontier. The troops in Metz and Nancy will be reinforced by a large force of the cavalry and infantry brought together by the extensive mobilization of the army reserves. The troops thus placed on the frontier will be ready to take up positions which they would have to hold in an effort to repulse an invasion of German troops.
