WORTHY WOMAN AT REST. Mrs. Mary Ann Rowberry Closes Long and Honored Career.

Special Correspondence. Tooele, Tooele Co., Aug. 27.—Funeral services were held here yesterday over the remains of Mrs. Mary Ann Gollister Rowberry, wife of the late Bishop John Rowberry. She had been in very feeble health for a number of years, and died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. J. M. Niles at Hagerman, Ida., on the 19th inst.

Mrs. Rowberry was born in Clinton county, Ill., July 24, 1829, and came to Utah about 1849, and was shortly after married to Bishop John Rowberry, coming to Tooele county in 1853, where, with her husband, she nobly shared all the trials and hardships incident to a pioneer life. She resided in this county for nearly half a century.

Mrs. Rowberry was a very gifted and talented woman in many respects, and will long be remembered for her kindness and benevolence to all who were suffering or in need. She was the mother of 11 children, seven of whom survived her. She was a true wife and a devoted mother.
