## BREVITIES.

In Brussels telegraphic dispatches are put in lamp-post boxes and regularly collected by carriers.

The biggest wheat grower in Minnesota cut his 2,000 acres with 15 reapers and 125 hands. His average is twenty-five bushels to the acre, of excellent quality.

The crop returns of 1889, as compared with 1888, condense as follows—less corn, more cotton, less tobacco, more wheat, more peaches, more potatoes, more hay, butter and cheese, less hops.

Wayne County, N. Y., estimates that its pepper crop this year will amount to \$50,000 in value. An average yield is twenty pounds of oil to the acre, and it now sells at \$3 per pound.

The Millington Telegraph makes the following apology: "We get out the Telegraph this week with a half-sheet. A press of business and a felon on the finger of one of our employees makes this necessary."

In order to cool water by evaporation, it has long been the practice in warm countries to wrap a pitcher or other vessel containing the water with a wet cloth, the evaporation from which served to reduce the temperature of the vessel and consequently of its contents. An English manufacturing firm have applied the same principle in a portable refrigerator. The inner vessel for holding the liquid or substance to be cooled is surrounded by an outer one containing water, and closed at the top by a layer of porous textile material. This draws up the water by capillary attraction, and the water, evaporating from the surface, produces the requisite reduction of temperature.
