SCHOOL BOARD MATTERS.

Board of Education Makes Another Demand on the County for Tax Money, Unlawfully Retained.

The board of education held a session last night, all members present except Toronto. Clerk Mortensen was instructed to make an official demand on the county for tax money unlawfully retained by him.

The matter is more fully set forth in the following resolution which was unanimously adopted:

Resolved, That the part of this board heretofore made in its efforts to exact from the county court the amount due the Salt Lake City schools an assessment can only be considered as a wrong, Dr. A. H. Whitney, Dr. A. B. Hubbard, Dr. George E. Elcock, Secretary and Treasurer.

Dr. Christiansen, of Provo, also spoke.

The principal topic of discussion was the necessity of formulating and drafting amendments to the present law regulating the practice of dentistry to be submitted to the Legislature at their next session.

The proposed law, as it stands, seems hardly adequate to the requirements of profession or the people for whom services it was enacted.

A committee was appointed consisting of Dr. George E. Whitney and Dr. A. B. Hubbard, to place the amendment before the Board of Health. Vacancies in the Board of dental examiners having to fill the recently passed resolutions made by the Board of Health of Ogden, Dr. A. H. Whitney, Dr. G. E. Elcock, Dr. A. B. Hubbard, and others will be presented to the Governor.

To the Editor:

Making the Sound of Roof Beams.

In these days of war plays and stage scenes the sound of roof beams is looked upon as a military necessity, unfortunately. Very few houses have roof beams, but those that do, are likely to be broken, and very few, indeed, make the noise right even if they had the supports. It takes quite a lot of practice to go to a good "house," as it is called. The necessary tools consist of a table black down to the timbers of a piece of paper. The operator has strapped to his hand half a coconut shell, on the edge of which is fastened a hammer. He starts in pounding them on the stick rafter to hammer roof beams to the timber and gradually works along to the door posts, and then goes to the corners, and finally ends up with a chair or bar stool, the house is paved up just outside the eaves.

India Rubber Tree Fruits.

The fruit of the India rubber tree is somewhat similar to that of the Rubber tree, the latex oil plant, though somewhat larger. The seeds have a not disagreeable taste and yield a purplish oil. It is a fairly good substitute for linseed oil, though it dries rapidly. Mixed with soap lye and turpentine, it makes a good varnish. The oil may be also used in the manufacture of soap and lithographic inks. The seeds are pointed and tiny-shoots, although rather slender.
