TERRIBLE FLOOD!

Much Grain Covered With Mud and Trash.—Heavy Loss.

FOUNTAIN GREEN, July 10, 1894.—Yesterday one of the largest floods that ever visited this part of the country was known as Big Hollow, and, spreading out upon farming land south of town, piled its tremendous force trash on a very large area of land, destroying much grain and doing damage to the amount of hundreds of dollars. The flood's course was so narrow that it will take approximately ten days to remove, in order to bring the land from the ground surface to a farm in which it can be properly irrigated. It is quite necessary for those to come near the Big Hollow to do so, as the water has covered the entire floor of the valley, so far as the eye can see, and the banks of the stream are so swift that the banks cannot cross them, and also the ground is very rocky.
