The Lillehammer Works near Stockholm completely burned to the ground. The fire was one of the biggest and most dangerous which for a long time has visited that part of the country.

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As a consequence of the vast influx to America of Swedes, in comparison to the number of their inhabitants, no economy has been practised as regards home demands until the very latest decades. The amount of wood largely used for buildings, fences, fuel and various other purposes, has determined, but it may certainly be regarded as far exceeding the figures of the export. Not until it is forgotten that for charcoal used in the production of iron, about five million cords of timber are annually required. Notwithstanding the vast home demand on wood the forests give so largely, that timber, in wrought or un wrought form, ranks first among Swedish exports. In the fifties and sixties the liberal opening with foreign markets gave rise to a number of industrial establishments for woodworks among which sawmills especially made rapid progress.

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
