**Labor Notes.**  
ST. LOUIS, Nov. 2.—The union job  
printers of this city have struck for an  
increase of \$1 per week.

NEW ORLEANS, Nov. 2.—A dispatch  
to the merchants here from Planter  
Lacasse says:

**THE STRIKERS**  
short four of my laborers this morning  
from ambush. I have telegraphed the  
governor for troops. Please see that  
they get out at once.

The Washington artillery were in-  
sulted by the strikers, and the latter  
and the officers are awaiting the action  
of the governor. Yesterday forty-five  
white laborers were sent to the Lacasse  
plantation to fill the places of  
the strikers, but whether the four men  
shot and arrested this morning were  
among this number or of those re-  
maining upon the plantation is not  
known.

A special to the Times-Democrat  
from Tigerville says regarding the  
shooting of the white men this  
morning that no

**ONE WAS KILLED,**  
but several persons were slightly hurt.  
It is quiet now as the new men have  
been put to work.

Dispatches from many plantations  
are striking in every way, and in many  
places have been given the alternative  
of returning to work or leaving the  
place. Trouble is expected to ensue  
when an effort is made in a day or two  
to force the strikers to leave the plan-  
tations.

blies, appealing for contributions in  
aid of the striking anthracite miners.
