THE LACE HOUSE FIRE.

Goods and Buttler Damaged to the Extent of \$6000—The Loss Covered by Insurance.

Only a few minutes before 12 o'clock last midnight Butlers were seen running from the roof of the Grosvenor & Huntington Law Houses on East Temple Street.

Sergeant Devany, who was near by, promptly turned in alarm at the signal fire. The department rolled out on good time and were sent at work in extinguishing the flames. The building was filled with an extensive and varied stock of costly goods, it seemed that all would go up in the flames. Several streams of water were turned into the air. Where the water did not reach the flames were under control. A large volume of water burst through the ceiling, and covered the ground floor, damaging the stock in the store.

The greatest loss will be to goods carried in the warehouses on the upper floors.

The fire, it is supposed, was caused by spontaneous combustion or an imperfectly insulated electric light wire.

The building is the property of William C. Jones, who is mostly to blame for the damage.
