TERRIFIC BATTLE .- A most graph'c account of the assault on Kineshaw Mountain, on the 27th ult, was specially dispatched to reliable report received. The attempt, by Gen. Sherman's order, was made, and greater bravery and determination could not have been exhibited. The heights in places were inacthat might have stood by Leonidas at Thermopy'æ. The men were so close to each other that stones and rocks burled from the heights did considerable damage. Among the killed were Col. Barnbill of the 4 h Illinois, and Col. Harmon of the 125th Illinois, also Brig. Gen. Harker, Capt. Augustine, 55th Illinois, Lieut.-Col. Wright, 103d Illinois, and Col. Silas Miller, 36th Illinois, were among the wounded. The loss along the whole line, dent says, "we failed in the main object of the assault." Col. Dan. McCook, commanding a brigade, is among the severely wounded, as well as Lieut.-Col. Boone, of Kentucky. The brigades of McCook and Mitchell lost about 700. In another part of the dispatch, it says three other brigades lost 300 or 400 men and 60 officers.
