FOREIGN.

The situation on the Dark Continent—Continued. Reports of Arabi's strength—Sudanese and Egyptian.

ALEXANDRIA, 24.—The electric light was established in force last night. It illuminated the country outside the walls for many miles, creating a round with striking effect. It did not, however, prevent Arabi's cavalry from passing 100 hundreds of men from the city.

The new native tribunal passed sentence today for the first time in the Ottoman Empire on a Muslim man on Christian evidence. The sentence will be carried out by the Khedive.

Khedive's Peacekeeping.

Arabi Pasha, in consequence of your departure to Kafo el Dowar, accompanied by the army, thus abandoning Alexandria without order, stopping railway trains, and cutting off communications through the postoffice, and impeding the return of refugees to their homes in Alexandria, and if you refuse to come to us after receiving orders, I demand you from the office of minister of war.

The Khedive issued the following circular to the admirals:

On perusing the order of dismissal of Arabi Pasha from the office of minister of war, you will know the great motives that necessitate his dismissal. Henceforward he will have no authority over you; whoever agrees with his designs and motives will be considered a participant in the crime; whoever shows obedience and conformity to our rule will deserve honor, courtesy and good remuneration. You must be aware that the country is saturated with dangers and perils, for the powers have agreed on Turkish intervention for the reform of the country, without damaging the privilege of war, you will know that I am convinced you will conform yourself to my orders, which cannot have any effect other than the welfare of the country. He who obeys my orders will be rewarded. He who does not will have to blame himself on being punished.

(Signed) THE KHEDIVÉ.

It is considered certain that Arabi will destroy Cairo, unless defeated and captured. In reply to the proclamation of the Khedive, Arabi appointed a ministry of his own at Cairo.

Preparations are made to attack Aboukir. Arabi is moving portions of his forces in that direction. Dispositions for Arabi, brought by a large mail steamer, were seized. It is stated that two of Arabi's colonels, acting as spies, entered the British camp and discovered the Khedive has requested a steamer to proceed to Dulgino to fetch 2,000 Albanians to act as his body guard.

The ministers have opposed the project, refusing to provide money for it.

A mail steamer from Constantinople which arrived this morning has been captured and the captain arrested on suspicion that he was conveying letters to Arabi Pasha. The steamer is guarded by four steam launches from the British fleet.

The British have chartered two ships to convey 800 mules from Limal to Cyprus. They will start for that port today.

The Mohandis canal continues to fall. It has fallen 14 inches in the last 48 hours.

Microbes are still caught with cotton balls in their pockets saturated with oil.

The public water supply of Alexandria has been cut off since noon yesterday.

Admiral Seymour has ordered all the machinery of the cotton press to be used in condensing water.

The Queen has expressed a wish that the Duke of Connaught participate in the Egyptian expedition.

The troops which sailed from Malta for Alexandria with 770 infantry, mules, carts and stores.

The Indian government replying to a telegram, stated that contingents for the Egyptian campaign could be embarked within a fortnight or three weeks.

Measures at Kafo for the protection of the Suez Canal were discussed at the cabinet council yesterday, and necessary credit will probably be moved in the Chamber of Deputies.

De Freycinet, President of the Council, had a long conference yesterday with Lord Lyons, the British ambassador.

Last night, 500 of Arabi's cavalry, with one gun, raided through Ramleh and rode between the English outposts. They came boldly to the water and then retired.

At 5 o'clock this morning, 500 Nubians, with eight guns, marched to Aboukir, under Abdallah Pasha, and immediately began to construct earthworks. Arabi now has 200 guns mounted on earthworks between Masallah and Kafo Dowar.

Stone Pasha informed me that unless the British will send at least 10,000 troops she will meet with a bull run.

Yesterday the *Bittern* cruised off the coast, but did not approach within five miles. The fleet has fifteen guns mounted. On the appearance of the *Bittern* the men to the guns did not fire.

At Aboukir there was a large number of guns and men. The flag of truce was flying but no English troops were landed to spite the game.

The country is drifting into fearful anarchy, atrocities equal to any even perpetrated in Bulgaria are committed with impunity. Two German at Teukh sheltered by the stationmaster until the train was ready to start, were caught entering the train, their hands held over the heads of the British troops.

A dispatch from Constantinople says there is reason to believe that Arabi Pasha sent an ultimatum to the British, asking them to evacuate the Suez Canal, and if they refused to do so, the Sultan would declare war on the British.

A dispatch from Alexandria on Sunday evening says the troop ship *Malabar*, with 1,100 men, and a battery of artillery, has arrived. According to the latest news from Cairo there are 8,000 starving, homeless persons, sleeping in the Eastern Gardens. There is great mortality among them.

Arabi Pasha yesterday passed 700 cavalry with a field gun at the pumping station of the British water works. It is supposed the intention is to destroy the station.

A dispatch from Port Said says Dr. Leases arrived on Saturday, accompanied by an old-camp of the Khedive. There are seventeen war vessels in the harbor. The English under Rear Admiral Hood, and the French under Admiral Drouot, the latter has consented to assist the Khedive in keeping order in the town and in protecting the lives and property of Europeans.
