To Return to Mexico the Trophies of War Captured by the United States in 1847.

THAT INTERNATIONAL MONETARY CONFERENCE.

The Commercial Treaty With Mexico and the Slave Trade Treaty.

By Telegram to the Senate.

THE MESSAGE.

Business Transacted by that Body Yesterday.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 11.—A large number of bills were reported from the committee and placed on the calendar.

A communication from Ryan, American minister to Mexico, in the late Mexican crisis, suggested that it would be a courteous and neighborly return to Mexico the trophies of war captured by the United States in 1847, was presented and referred to the committee on foreign relations.

The resolution declared that it is the determined policy of the United States government to use both gold and silver as the full legal tender money, either under the ratio now existing in the United States or any other ratio hereafter established, the United States alone of its accord with other nations.

It directed the president to invite the governments of the countries comprising the so-called Latin Union, and such other nations as may be deemed advisable, to join the United States in the conference, and to accept of a common ratio between gold and silver for the purpose of establishing ultimately the full legal tender money, and of securing a fair and relative value between these two metals.

Whenever the governments, or any three of them, shall have agreed to settle, whether in the judgment of the president, a sufficient number of nations shall have entered into such international agreement, the president is to declare the ratio fixed to be the legal ratio in the United States. The president is to appoint and send three not more than five commissioners, whose reports to him shall be transmitted to Congress, and who shall each receive \$5000 and reasonable expenses.

Senator Taylor spoke at some length in advocacy of the resolution.

Senator Stewart submitted a statement in connection with the resolution, and the committee on foreign relations was referred to the committee on foreign relations.

Senator Morgan introduced a resolution, which was referred to the committee on foreign relations.

SHIELDS TESTIMONY CORROBORATED.

VALPARAISO, Cal., Jan. 11.—Nothing very new was elicited at the "Hullman" investigation today, the evidence being chiefly directed to corroborating that already taken, and to showing the persistent activity of the Valparaiso police in the day of the riot.

A score of witnesses were examined. All were arrested by the police and confined for two days.

The search for the man who is supposed to have been the instigator of the riot, which broke out on the night of the 15th, is being continued.
