Tintic Stocks Were in Strong Demand and Colorado and Others Go Higher.

COLUMBUS CON. NOW LISTED.

Ohio Copper the Most Active of the Unlisted Stocks—Closing Quotations.

The Knight Tintic issues furnished some of the features of the forenoon session of the mining exchange. Colorado came up strong, starting with the sale of 400 shares at 42½; it continued to climb, ending at 44. The Beck Tunnel was also in fine form and likewise Iron Blossom, Sioux Consolidated weakened. Uncle Sam Consolidated moved up a few points, ending with a sale at 74 cents. Columbus Consolidated was admitted as a listed stock. A bid of \$5.50 was made for it, with a low of \$5.25. Uncle Sam sold at 63.
