Parker, Fremont Co., Ida., Jan. 21.—We are having very unusual weather here since New Year's. Slighting is almost impracticable; in fact, some of the fields show bare ground, and the snow wagon roads. During this time it has been an almost continual thaw.

VICTIMS OF DIPHTHERIA.

Although the sun is shining overhead there is a dark cloud hanging over the town of Parker, Idaho. The cause of this is the diphtheria, which has been doing its deadly work since the first of the year. The first victim was a young girl, who died on the 17th inst. This was the sixth death in this ward. Two or three of the deaths were of children, and the disease is very dangerous. All kinds of public gatherings, religious as well as educational, have been discontinued for some weeks.

The railroad having done away with most of the team traffic, times are quite dull so far this winter. The only employment worth mentioning is logging for the saw mills. The cedar posts, which were so plentiful in this locality when it was first settled, are nearly exhausted; though, strange to say, the cedar is the cheaper.
