ARRESTS LATES OFF BY WEEKS

Major Noble sentenced to Twenty-five Years' Imprisonment—Said for Damages.

A dispatch from Salt Lake City, says that R. N. Noble, the owner of the Tribune and Evening News, has been sentenced to twenty-five years in the state prison.

Major Noble, in 1881, was sentenced to twenty-five years in the state prison for the same offense. He was released in 1884, and has since been living in Salt Lake City.
