# Last Evening's Lecture.—G. W. Stayer delivered a lecture on Love, or Enchantment and Reality, last evening, in the 20th Ward school house, under the auspices of the Institute of that ward.

The lecturer prefaced his subject by relating the story of the "Enchanted Home" told of in the tales of the Arabian Nights, to illustrate the "wisdom" with which many young people will follow some enchanting, romantic tales, and near beyond their own domain, to only find themselves, after traveling through dark and perilous paths, battling with privation and suffering.

He classified life into three divisions—youth, maturity and old age.

In youth we see their countenances beaming with intelligence—the tallness of influence, the origin of greatness—the electric spark that creates nature and makes creation do our bidding. In looking upon a young man he silently inquires—what will that youth accomplish in life; will he take rank among the benefactors or with the scourges of his race—will he set an example of patriotic virtue, or will he manifest selfish and cruel ambition? If he has genius will he consecrate it like Milton and Dickens to the common cause of humanity, or sacrifice his talents on the polluted altar of immorality and crime? Will that immortal intelligence ally itself with the Creator in the cause of righteousness and thus rise to the sublime heights of exalted purity, or will it array its powers with the enemies of truth and wage unrighteous war against God's kingdom?

To the young, he said, life is in prospect as a fairy tale with enchanted scenery, but time, that good old friend, soon dissipates our romances, and we find ourselves grappling with the reality of life.

He showed what many of the enchantments of life are, held up worthy examples for emulation, and made some very telling thrusts at the follies very common among people of all classes.

His references were to both male and female, contending that the latter are co-equal with the lords of creation in natural power of intellect, and were one and inseparable in the organization of perfect society.

Exhorting all to learn well the principles of integrity, industry and economy, as being the most essential to a prosperous life, that with the element called talent, mixed with the love of God, the greatest happiness can be obtained.

**Museum.**—Mrs. Martha J. Coray writes from Man, Jacob County, respecting an Indian relic noticed in our columns, as having been found in that locality and presented to the Museum. Sister Coray states that the stone implement, found at a depth of two and a half feet, was struck against by a plow when excavating for a canal. It is a very curious-looking stone implement, resembling a war club in shape, about 22 inches in length, 124 inches in girth, tapering to the handle, which terminates in a knob. It seems that the implement had been placed upright in the ground like a tombstone, and was close to a patch of earth which looked like a place where some one had been buried. Sister Coray suggests that it may have been an ancient grave. Fragments of bone were subsequently found, and dark deposits of earth, in the immediate vicinity. All of these facts are very interesting and worthy of being placed on record, especially as coming from a lady, who is a close observer and whose statements can be relied on.

The history of the former races who lived in these valleys is at present unwritten, and everything calculated to throw light on the past should be preserved for future reference.

This interesting relic was found near the foot of Mount Nebo, on the western slope of that venerable old mountain, trending toward Salt Creek. It is already attracting the attention of intelligent visitors to this city, who desire to become acquainted with ethnological facts relating to the pre-historic races.

The curator also acknowledged the receipt of the Annual Catalogue of Bowdoin College, Brunswick, Maine, for 1878-9. Also coins received from Dr. J. B. Richards, among which may be named a copper medal of George II. date 1745. The obverse represents the king, the reverse shows the islands of Great Britain surrounded by a sword held aloft directed menacingly towards the highlands of Auld Scotia, alluding to the landing of the Pretender in that part of the British dominions.
