FRANCE'S FOREIGN POLICY.

Statement by the Minister of Foreign
Affairs.

PARIS, May 31.—In the course of his
speech, the minister of foreign
affairs, made an important statement
regarding the foreign policy of the
government, in which he declared that
France's national interests were subor-
dinated to the interests of other powers.
He explained that the past which
France took in the European representa-
tions to Japan was dictated by the
interests of France, and that the
protection shown to French rights
in the Far East, France could not
be independent of the United States.
A permanent Japanese occupation
of the Far East, he said, would be
a serious danger to France, and he
declared that France would not allow
itself to be in a position of inferiority
to the United States.
