The Commissioner of Internal Revenue has something to say to medicine makers.

An incendiary fire destroyed \$20,000 worth of property in Mobile.

The latest phase of Chinese smuggling—fourteen women who arrived from the "Flower Land" per steamer at San Francisco yesterday, had on eighty-four silk gowns and thirty-seven of paislows. The exceeding girth of the ladies excited suspicion, and a search of the police led to the above discovery.

**THE OLD SPIRIT.**

True old spirit of opposition to the municipal authorities and municipal ordinances is once more manifested. Men, and women, where better things might have been expected. It is done apparently with the conviction of the oppositionists and offenders that they have a "friend in court" against whom position and well known proclivities give them confidence in favorable treatment of their case, so far as his influence extends.

Nothing can be said in favor of this sort of opposition, this defiance of the local government. It is objectionable in every way to all good citizens. If any citizens have grievances or think they have there are proper ways of seeking redress. But many grievances are merely imaginary.

One of the greatest grievances of these oppositionists, as asserted, is the high rate of license charged for some businesses.

The arrangement of taxation chiefly on luxuries, adopted by the English government, is regarded as very excellent and efficient. Some of the licenses most complained of in this city are those upon luxuries—liquors, billiards, etc. Nobody need complain of them. They are undoubtedly better to heavy license such businesses than those connected with the necessities of life, and all good citizens will resent the manner in which they are framed with such intent. The persons immediately concerned who may think their licenses too heavy, use all proper means to demand the city authorities to lessen it. But it is not the part of a good citizen to defy the authorities, and no good citizen will do it. That is the part of a desperado, an outlaw, who care not if he spreads anarchy everywhere, provided his wishes are granted.

**INCENDIARISM IN MONTANA.**—About two o'clock in the morning of Sept. 5, Trahan's photograph gallery, Helena, Montana, was discovered in flames. A bullet through the door of the gallery was found a black oil-cloth mat, stuffed with cotton batting, well saturated with oil and turpentine. Two bottles filled with coal oil were in the mat, and also three cigar boxes, nine sticks of candles and other combustible matter. The Helena Gazette says the gallery was in the heart of a low, large wooden buildings, dry to timber, and the fire, once fully under way, no earthly power could have saved the business, property, or persons from becoming a mass of smouldering ruins. Next door to the gallery was the Cosmopolitan Hotel, full of sleeping guests—men, women and children. A few minutes' longer play for the fire, and the hotel would have been enveloped in flames. The hotel had been unoccupied for a week, and a general death might have been the fate of some of the inmates.

The Gazette thinks it is plain that the fire was a bare attempt at the destruction of life and property in the city. A reward of a thousand dollars has been offered for the capture of the incendiary.

While the fire was going on, a rough and tumble, kick, scratch, gouge, and bite fight occurred in another part of the city, at a distance from the burning building fifteen minutes with desperate fury, until one of the belligerents "chawed up" one of the fingers of the other and forced him to cry mercy. It was the most desperate and brutal fight ever seen in Helena.

**A FIRE OF VANDALISM.**—Our dispatches a few days ago mentioned the fact of an outrage committed on the remains of the late "Beau Hickman," and that the bones were under way for the disinterment and prosecution of the murderer. The Washington Star, however, informs the act a "bold and impudent" one.

A number of men, dressed in rags, were gathered around the body. They had torn off the garments, and the grave clothes were mingled with the dirt and nothing but the hide of "Beau Beau," except the brain, was left in the coffin. The same bones had cut at the ankles, the legs cut at the knee, and the flesh laid over the bone, unbroken, and the skin, had been pulled from the body. The skin of the face, with the nose and head torn off, lay on the floor.
